My main professional interest is to understand how young people's interactions with their intra- and interpersonal worlds influence their healthy development and thriving. My research considers the interaction between the individual young person and his or her social world, which includes families, schools, and communities, and how these interactions shape development. Working from a strengths-based perspective, I draw on my experiences from the United States and Malaysia to explore the mechanisms through which healthy, holistic youth development occurs within and across different cultural settings. Specifically, past and current work includes:
